- A shareholder of the Arctic Slope Regional Corporation,

Application Submission: Completed applications must be submitted electronically no later than September 6, 2019. An application is considered "complete" only if it is accompanied by the following documents. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. Current Resume
2. Personal Narrative

A written statement, (one page maximum, 11pt. font, with name, school and major area of study in the upper right hand corner) describing your motivation for attending the conference, including what you think you will achieve from the conference, and summary of your professional and academic goals.

3. Unofficial transcript - must show cumulative GPA
