

General Fact Sheet | Terp Young Scholars Program

The Terp Young Scholars Program at the University of Maryland (UMD) and ASRC Federal invite **ASRC Shareholder High School Students** to participate in an immersive three-week pre-college experience. Students enroll in the course of their choosing, go on field trips around DC, and see what it's like to live and succeed in college. Students attend one course of their choosing and stay in dorms with students from around the country at the UMD College Park campus, which is only a few miles from ASRC Federal's headquarters in Beltsville, Maryland. The Terp Young Scholars Program is for highly motivated, college-bound high school students who want to learn first-hand what it takes to succeed in college.

Program Details

- **Program Dates: July 12 – July 31, 2020** (not including potential travel days).
 - Three week-long program. ASRC Federal Scholarship recipients arrive a day early and leave a day later than Program Dates.
- Students live and eat on University of Maryland, College Park campus.
- Students attend class in the morning five days a week and participate in field trips/social activities in the evenings and on weekends.
- Upon successful completion of their course, students have the opportunity to receive up to three University of Maryland credits that are transferrable to most universities and colleges across the country.

Courses are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis so applying early is recommended! Below are a few of the courses available for the 2020 summer:

- **Creative Writing**
- **Environmental Biology**
- **Think like an Economist**
- **Intro to Computer Programming**
- **Discovering Architecture**
- **Engineering Design**

Scholarships are awarded to the first eight eligible ASRC Shareholder High School Students who apply and are then accepted to the program by the University of Maryland. To be eligible for the scholarship, a student **MUST** return the ASRC Federal application form **BEFORE** applying with the University of Maryland online system. The ASRC Federal Terp Young Scholars Program Scholarship covers the cost of program tuition and lodging, transportation costs, and lodging during travel. Scholarships **DO NOT** cover baggage fees, books and course supplies, or spending money.

Application Procedure

Students must have completed 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade and have a 3.0 GPA

Official Scholarship Rules | ASRC Federal Terp Young Scholars Program Scholarship | 2020

1. **Eligibility:** Shareholders of the Arctic Slope Regional Corporation (“ASRC”) who have completed 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade as of June 15, 2020; who are under the age of 18 at the time of travel; and who have received a GPA of at least 3.0 are eligible to enter the ASRC Federal Young Scholars Sponsorship Contest (the “Contest”).

2. **Contest Period:** The Contest begins at 9:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time on February 1, 2020 and ends at 11:59 p.m. Alaska Standard Time on April 1, 2020 or until all 8 scholarships have been awarded, whichever occurs first (the “Contest Period”). Entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. Alaska Standard Time on April 1, 2020 to be eligible. Limit one entry per person and per e-mail address.

3. How to Enter:

2. Once ASRC Federal has received the student’s application, verified eligibility, and responded with an online UMD application code– **Student will then be able to complete the Terp Young Scholars Program application via the University of Maryland website:**

4. **Selection of Winner and Awarding of Prize:** The University of Maryland Terp Young Scholars Program will select eight awardees from among all eligible entries with at least a 3.5 GPA on a first come, first serve basis. Those applicants that have a 3.4-3.0 GPA will be waitlisted. If there are not eight eligible entries with at least a 3.5 GPA, the University of Maryland Terp Young Scholars Program will select students to fill the remaining slots from the waitlisted 3.4-3.0 GPA students on a first come, first serve basis. Awardees will be notified by phone and/or e-mail, at Sponsor’s discretion, on or about May 13, 2020. Return of any notification as undeliverable may result in disqualification, and an alternate may be selected. Judges’ decisions are final and binding in all respects. The winners will be announced on or about May 13, 2020.

5. **Prizes:** The Prize consists of round trip airfare and program costs to attend the 2020 Terp Young Scholars Program at the University of Maryland in College Park, MD from July 12-31, 2020. The Prize **does not include** baggage fees, books and course supplies, and spending money during the program and while traveling. All expenses and costs associated with the acceptance or use of the prize that are not expressly specified in the foregoing prize description are the responsibility of the winner.
